<p>Hereby constitutes and appoints EVANGELINA F RAMIREZ dba EFR Customhouse Brokerage and its licensed officers and employees, specifically authorized to act for said corporation by power of attorney as a true and lawful agent and attorney of the grantor named above for and in the name, place, and stead of said grantor from this date and in all Customs Districts, and in no other name, to make, endorse, sign, declare, or swear to any entry, withdrawal, declaration, certificate, bill of lading, carnet or other document required by law or regulation in connections with the importation, transportation, or exportation (including export control documents) of any merchandise shipped or consigned by or to said grantor, to perform any act or condition which may be required by law or regulation in connection with such merchandise; to receive any merchandise deliverable to said grantor;</p> <p>To act as forwarding agent for the purpose of export control and export clearance for grantor. Grantor hereby certifies that the information provided for the purposes of export control and export clearance is complete and accurate;</p> <p>To make endorsements on bills of lading conferring authority to transfer title, make entry or collect drawback, and to make, sign, declare, swear to any statement, supplemental statement, schedule, supplemental schedule, certificate of delivery, certificate of manufacture, certificate of manufacture and delivery, abstract of manufacturing records, declaration of proprietor on drawback entry, declaration of exporter on drawback entry, or any other affidavit or document which may be required by law or regulation for drawback purposes, regardless of whether such bill of lading, sworn document, schedule, certificate, abstract, declaration, or other affidavit or document is intended for filing in any customs district; or</p> <p>To sign, seal, and deliver for and as the act of said grantor and bond required by law or regulation in connection with the entry or withdrawal of imported merchandise or merchandise exported with or without benefit of drawback, or in connection with the entry, clearance, lading, unloading or navigation of any vessel or other means of</p>	<p>conveyances owned or operated by said grantor, and any and all bonds which may be voluntarily given and accepted under applicable laws and regulations, consignee's and owner's declarations provided for in section 485, Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, or affidavits in connection with the entry of merchandise. To sign and swear to any document and to perform any act that may be necessary or required by law or regulation in connection with the entering, clearing, lading, unloading, or operation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor;</p> <p>To authorize other customs brokers to act as grantor's agent; to receive, endorse and collect checks issued for Customs duty refunds in grantor's name drawn on the Treasurer of the United States. if the grantor is a nonresident of the United States, to accept service of process on behalf of the grantor;</p> <p>And generally to transact at the customhouse in any district any and all customs business, including making, signing, and filing of protests under section 514 Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, in which said grantor is or may be concerned or interested and which may properly be transacted or performed by an agent and attorney giving said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything whatever requisite and necessary to be done in the premises as fully as said grantor could do if present and acting, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents, the foregoing power of attorney to remain in full force and effect until (7) ___ of ___ or until notice of revocation in writing is duly given to and received by a District Director of Customs. If the donor of this power of attorney is a partnership, the said power shall in no case have any force or effect after the expiration of 2 years from the date of its execution.</p>

Customs powers of attorney of residents (including resident corporations) shall be without power of substitution except for the purpose of executing Shipper's export declarations. However, a power of attorney executed in favor of a licensed customs broker may specify that the power of attorney is granted to the customs broker to act through any of its licensed officers or any employee specifically authorized to act for such customs broker by power of attorney. If you are the importer of record, payment to the broker will not relieve you of liability for Customs charges (duties, taxes or other debts owed to Customs) in the event the charges are not paid by the broker. Therefore, if you pay by check, Customs charges may be paid with a separate check payable to the "Customs & Border Protection" which shall be delivered to CBP by the broker. Importers who wish to utilize this procedure must contact our office in advance to arrange timely receipt of any duty checks. Should it become necessary to commence any action to collect sums due for services rendered or other benefits provided pursuant to this Power of Attorney, Evangelina F Ramirez shall be entitled to recover all costs and expenses including attorney's fees for services in connection with such action or proceeding in such amount as the court may adjudge reasonable as and for attorney's fees. 02/2014
